Please join us for the 2021 Biology Department Diploma Ceremony(s) on **Friday, May 21st, between 11 am-12 pm and 1-2 pm in Strong Auditorium, Upper Level (River Campus)**. Senior Biology department majors may participate in-person or remotely; however, we need to know your plans in advance to prepare. All Biology department majors must complete this survey regardless of their participation in the ceremony.**

By now, seniors should have received details regarding commencement activities from Event and Conference Management (ECM) for the <u>AS&E Commencement Ceremony</u> that takes place on Thursday the 20th. Please note that these are two different events. Students usually attend both; however, they operate independently from one another. Be sure to hang your regalia up after the AS&E ceremony on Thursday to be in good condition for the Diploma Ceremony on Friday.

THE WALK ACROSS STAGE (in-person & virtual)

In-Person Attendees: Halfway through the ceremony, staff will direct graduates to walk up to the stage. As they cross the stage, biology faculty will hand out diploma cases, and an announcer will read personalized messages from the graduates to the audience. <u>Virtual Attendees</u> Remote participants can expect to watch the ceremony as if they are in the audience until their turn to receive their diploma. After in-person participants walk the stage, ECM Technical support staff will live-stream graduates to the screen on the front stage. The announcer will read personalized messages for virtual attendees and will follow the same format as in-person participants; except, virtual graduates will personally deliver their own parting words and goodbyes to the audience. ONLINE STREAMING FOR GUESTS: Due to covid capacity restrictions, only graduates can attend. The college has arranged to live-stream all diploma ceremonies. ECM will post links for each event to the <u>Commencement 2021</u> <u>Website</u> / <u>Diploma Ceremonies</u> webpage so you can share them with your family and friends before the big day. There will be a different link for graduates who are participating virtually.

PICTURES AVAILABLE FOR DOWNLOAD AFTER THE CEREMONY: The College has also made arrangements for photographs to be taken and free for download. Event and Conference Management (ECM) should be sending more information about this shortly.

DIPLOMAS: The Registrar will be contacting graduates directly regarding their mailing information. Graduates should take the diploma cases home with them to store their diploma when it arrives.

LATIN HONORS: It is unclear if information about latin honors will be distributed to the departments in time for the diploma ceremonies. The announcer will read if the department is given this information. Guidelines for Latin honor are posted to the <u>CCAS website for Honors and Distinctions</u>.
