Application Process

- 1. Find a Research Mentor who will agree to sponsor a summer research project and supervise the writing of a proposal.
 - For tips visit the UPBM Finding a Research Mentor Website.
- 2. Complete Part A. Intent to Apply Form and submit by March 1st
 - Will receive confirmation e-mail with "Edit Link" to Part B upon submission
- 3. Complete Part B. by writing and uploading the following materials by the first Monday back after Spring Break:
 - Formal Research Proposal
 - Relevant Professional Experience Summary
 - Research / Career Goals Summary
- 4. Ask research mentor to write a letter of support and Statement of Authorship to the UPBM committee by deadline
 - Mentors should e-mail letters of support and statement of authorship to the UPBM Program Coordinator
- 5. Ask another faculty member to write a second letter of support to the UPBM committee and e-mail it to UPBM Program Manager_by deadline as well.

Contact the UPBM Program Manager with any difficulties or questions.

Selection Process

This fellowship is competitive, as the number of positions is limited. All application materials and academic records will be reviewed and ranked by the UPBM Committee. Decisions should be communicated to the applicants by mid-April.
