RISE TO MODERN MUSICAL THEATER

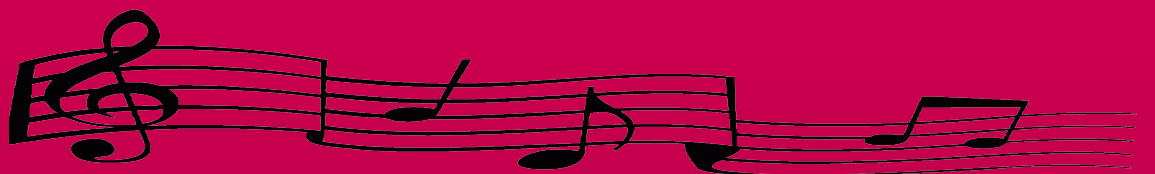
