2015 Health and Human Values Creative Excellence Award Guidelines and Entry Form

The Health and Human Values Creative Excellence Award is given each year to a student who submits a work of art that provides a unique perspective on the meaning of human life as revealed in health and health care. The entries will be judged on the originality of perspective they present, on their connection to meaning of human life in health and health care, on the skill of their presentation, and on their overall quality by the Health and Human Values Cluster Committee

Guidelines:

- The contest is open to all University of Rochester undergraduate and graduate students, including the College of Arts, Science, and Engineering, the School of Medicine and Dentistry, the School of Nursing, the Warner School of Education, the Simon School of Business, etc.
- Entries may be in any artistic medium: painting, sculpture, poetry, photography, personal essays, fiction, etc. The work itself must not include your name or any other identifying factor.
- Entries are limited to one per person.
- Entries must not have been previously published in any form.
- Entries must be accompanied by a cover sheet (attached) identifying you and your submission. (The work itself must not include your name or any other identifying factor.) Cover sheets are also available in the Medical Center in the Division of Medical Humanities & Bioethics (G-8011), and on the River Campus in the Multidisciplinary Studies Center in Dewey 4-209B.
- Please bring or send your entries to Christine Donnelly at the Medical Center in G-8011 or to Jennifer Sherwood on the River Campus in Dewey 4-209B. The <u>submission deadline</u> is **Friday**, **March 20** at 4:00 pm.
- All submissions will be handled confidentially. Non-winning fine art/photography submissions should be picked up within 30 days after winners have been announced.

The winner will receive a \$200 award and a plaque, and prizes will be given to Honorable Mention winners. Winners will be announced in May, and prize money will be awarded at that time. Winners will be honored at the Annual Ethics and Humanities Grand Rounds Dinner (usually held in the Fall) and award plaques will be presented at that time. Winners' names will be added to the Cluster award plaques on display in the corridor adjacent to the Miner Library. Winning entries will be displayed in a case at the entrance of the Miner Library, and on the website of the Cluster.
