Auditions must be recorded in one uninterrupted session, not to exceed ten minutes. You may record your audition as many times as you wish prior to submitting your preferred take, but you may not stop in between selections or edit your final presentation.

- **Audition Requirements:**
- *** Introduction,** to include your name, area of study (college major, if declared), and a short description of your study on the instrument.
- Perform one jazz piece from standard literature (American popular songbook or bebop). Performance can be solo or with a backing track.
- Perform 2 two-octave major scales in keys of your choosing.
- Perform the chord comping excerpt ("Line for Lyons" <u>below</u>) –
 based upon the chord symbols above the melody. The melody
 is not required.
- Improvise on a blues with a backing track or without a backing track.
